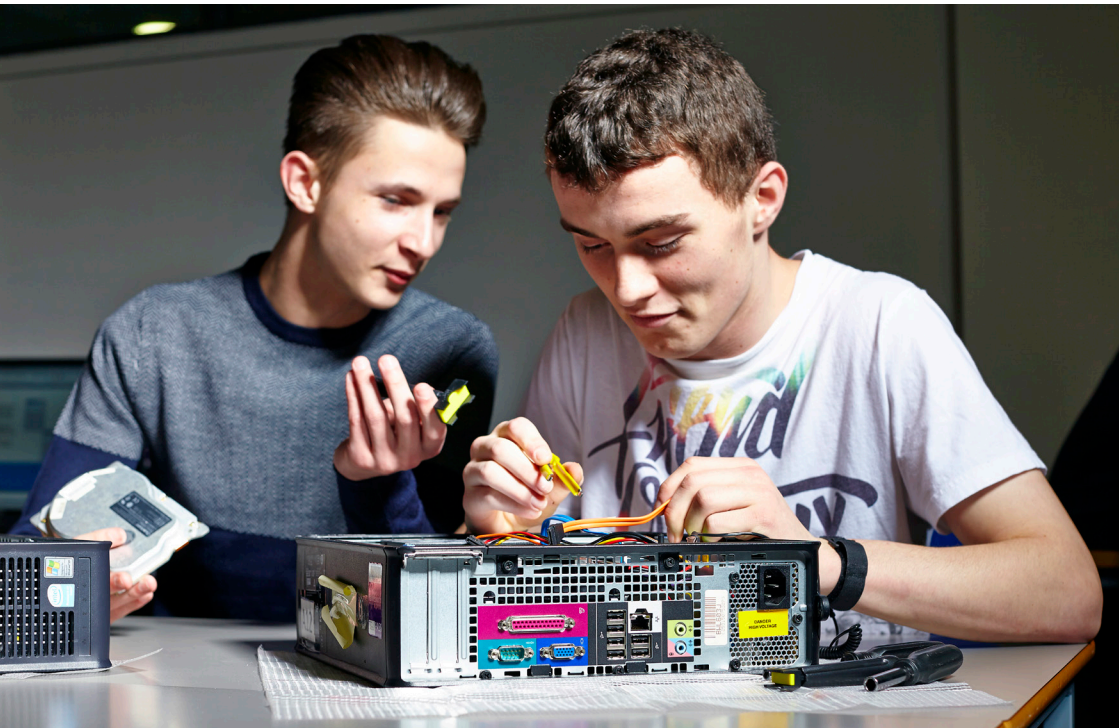


# Digital Training at New College Durham

New College Durham is now delivering a range of free digital qualifications aimed at upskilling employees who live in Durham, Northumberland and Tyne & Wear. The aim is to work closely with local employers to address any digital skills gaps that you may have in your workforce.

Employees can sign up for training such as an a range of introductory short workshops looking at digital file management, spreadsheets, databases, presentations or enrol on one of a range of accredited programmes such as:

- Smart Digital - Entry level
- Essential Digital Skills for Work (EDSQ) - Entry level 3
- Essential Digital Skills for Work (EDSQ) - Level 1
- I/ECDL qualifications at levels 1-3
